The current board will select the most suitable candidates that apply for each position. They will be presented on the slate of new board members to be approved at our 2014 Annual General Meeting (April 9th 2014, Banff Alberta). New board members will be asked to attend our AGM in Banff – travel expenses will be covered by CSMB/SCBM.
